**I.- VISA REQUIREMENTS (Mandatory)**

1. 2 (two) Copies of the Application forms duly completed by hand and in capital letters.  
Applicants are required to sign the form in front of a Consular Officer.
2. 2 (Two) recent photographs with white background, size 4cm x 4cm.
3. 1 (One) copy of all pages of the passport except the empty ones.
4. Letter of employment (please mention salary and all bonuses that the company provides as well as the date of joining).
5. The original last three months summary personal bank statement or stamp photocopy.
6. Airline ticket. A booking will be sufficient when the application is handed over to this Embassy, but once their visa has been approved the applicants have to submit the Original one.
7. Hotel Reservation (guaranteed by credit card) and must show the applicant's name for the duration of the stay in Argentina or statement from a travel agency showing tourist program, etc.
8. Travel insurance (Worldwide coverage for at least the time you will stay in Argentina).
9. Original passport and UAE residence visa valid for at least 6 months from the date the application is submitted. In case your visa is about to expire, we require a letter from your employer, declaring that they have no objection to renew the visa upon your return.
10. If you are invited by a person in Argentina, you must submit a signed invitation letter which must include the complete address and a phone number, this letter has to be certified by a public notary and legalized by the Chamber of Notaries of Argentina.

**Note: Please glue the photo onto the visa application form in the designated space and please  
**DO NOT STAPLE** any document.**

## **II.- ADDITIONAL TO VISA REQUIREMENTS**

### **a) For business travellers**

- Original Invitation Letter (Attested by Notary Public and RENURE inscription from company in Argentina who is inviting) stating business purpose & duration of visit.
- Letter from the Employer in UAE confirming the trip and stating that company takes responsibility for the employee's expenses.

### **b) For private invitations:**

- Letter from the invitee, stating his/her name, address and telephone numbers. Attested by Notary Public in Argentina.

### **c) For working purposes in Argentina**

- Letter from Sponsor in the UAE stating duration of employment, salary and position. In the cases of partners or owners of the company please include copy of the Chamber of Commerce Registration.

## **III.- OTHER INFORMATION:**

- Visa approval could take up to 25 days therefore we advice to apply for the visa at least 45 days prior to the travel date.
- Visa stamp takes 3 working days.
- Visa validity will be for 90 days from the date of issue.
- Other documents may be requested as deemed necessary by Consular Staff.
- The Embassy will not be responsible for any mistakes in the visas which were not brought to its attention by the passport holder prior to departure to Argentina.

- Application Submission: **SUNDAY TO TUESDAY ONLY**. Please note that an appointment is necessary to come and submit the application. Please write us an e-mail to: consular\_earb@mrecic.gov.ar once you have all the documents required for the application.
- Regardless of her / his nationality the applicant should come **PERSONALLY** and be on time, failure to come in person and on time the appointment will be cancelled and a new one will need to be schedule.

- **Business: 370.00 AED (Indian & Moroccan passport holders are exempted)**
- **Transit: 74.00 AED**
